 2 RELATING TO PHARMACY; AMENDING SECTION 54-1718, IDAHO CODE, TO CLARIFY BACK-
 3 GROUND CHECK REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICANTS AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORREC-
 4 TIONS.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 54-1718, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
 7 amended to read as follows:

8 54-1718. LICENSURE AND DISCIPLINE. (1) The board of pharmacy shall be
 9 responsible for the control and regulation of the practice of pharmacy in
 10 this state including, but not limited to, the following:

- 11 (a) The licensing by examination or by reciprocity of applicants who
- 12 are qualified to engage in the practice of pharmacy under the provisions
- 13 of this act chapter;
- 14 (b) The renewal of licenses to engage in the practice of pharmacy;
- 15 (c) The determination and issuance of standards for recognition and ap-
- 16 proval of schools and colleges of pharmacy whose graduates shall be el-
- 17 ible for licensure in this state, and the specification and enforce-
- 18 ment of requirements for practical training, including internship;
- 19 (d) The enforcement of the provisions of this act chapter relating to
- 20 the conduct or competence of pharmacists practicing in this state, and
- 21 the suspension, revocation or restriction of licenses to practice phar-
- 22 macy;
- 23 (e) The regulation of the training, qualifications and employment of
- 24 pharmacy interns.

25 (2) The board of pharmacy shall require ~~all applicants for original li-~~
 26 ~~icensure or registration and for reinstatement of licenses or registrations~~
 27 the following applicants to submit to a fingerprint-based criminal history
 28 check of the Idaho central criminal history database and the federal bureau
 29 of investigation criminal history database;

- 30 (a) Original applicants for licensure or registration;
- 31 (b) Applicants for reinstatement of a license or registration that has
- 32 been suspended or revoked; and
- 33 (c) Applicants for reinstatement of a license or registration that has
- 34 lapsed for a period of time that is more than one (1) year.

35 Each applicant ~~for original licensure or registration or for reinstatement~~
 36 ~~of licensure or registration~~ shall submit a completed ten (10) finger fin-
 37 gerprint card or scan to the board of pharmacy at the time of application and
 38 shall pay the cost of the criminal history check.
