## Re: Executive Order 2017-06, The Licensing Freedom Act

Lieutenant Governor Little:

The Board of Pharmacy ("BOP") applauds your leadership on occupational licensing reform, as outlined in Executive Order 2017-06, the Licensing Freedom Act.

The BOP shares your commitment to protecting public health and safety while using the lightest possible hand of government. The BOP is proud to maintain some of the lowest licensing fees related to the pharmacy industry when compared to other U.S. states and territories. The BOP has also voluntarily led efforts to eliminate and minimize licensing burdens. Over the past 18 months, the BOP has:

- Eliminated six (6) categories of licensure that were unnecessary. As one example, gas stations that sell over-the-counter drugs (e.g., Tylenol) can continue their activities without the need for a BOP registration.
- Reduced the overall regulatory burden by cutting 55% of the BOP rules by word count and 62% of the restrictions.
- Minimized barriers to entry for licensure. As one example, the BOP eliminated use of the Multistate Pharmacy Jurisprudence Examination (MPJE) as a precondition to pharmacist licensure. This move saved license applicants \$250, and cut processing time by 60 days.

As a result of these efforts, the BOP won the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy's (NABP) 2018 Fred T. Mahaffey Award and has drawn substantial interest from other states as a model of regulatory reform.

We have included information on our website regarding the Licensing Freedom Act since summer 2017. We have held more than fifteen (15) town hall sessions for licensees throughout the state to collect feedback on BOP regulations. We have identified four (4) additional areas to enhance our licensing laws as detailed in the enclosed report, and we intend to move forward with these policy improvements through agency bills and rulemaking.

We stand ready to work with you and your office to further improve our licensing efforts.

## Assessment of Public Interest

Per I.C. § [54-1702](#):

The practice of pharmacy in the state of Idaho is declared a professional practice affecting the health, safety and welfare of the public and is subject to regulation and control in the public interest. It is further declared to be a matter of public interest and concern that the practice of pharmacy, as defined in this chapter, merits and receives the confidence of the public and that only qualified persons be permitted to engage in the practice of pharmacy in or into the state of Idaho. This chapter shall be liberally construed to carry out these objects and purposes.

All 50 states and the District of Columbia license individuals and facilities who engage in the practice of pharmacy because of the clear and present dangers associated with the practice and the drugs involved (e.g., opioids). As one example, poor compounding practices by a pharmacy in Massachusetts in 2012 sickened over 800 individuals and resulted in the deaths of 76 people.

Further, the United States is in the middle of a nationwide opioid epidemic. Federal law requires a closed system of distribution for controlled substances (e.g., opioids), and state boards of pharmacy are tasked with licensing, inspections, and investigations to minimize the chance for drug diversion.

The Board of Pharmacy balances these well-known public safety risks with the lightest possible hand of government, and uses the

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Model Act published by the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy to ensure our restrictions are on par with, and not exceeding, those in other jurisdictions. Leveraging the Model Act also ensures portability and mobility of Idaho licenses.

### **Recommendations for Improvement, Modification, or Elimination of Requirements**

The Board of Pharmacy has made a concerted effort over the past few years to eliminate obsolete and unneeded licenses, remove barriers to entry, and streamline regulations. In fact, the Board cut 55% of its total regulations by word count during its 2017 rulemaking. Still, the Board has identified four suggestions to reduce barriers to entry for licensees:

- (1) Formally eliminate the Multistate Pharmacy Jurisprudence Examination as a precondition to pharmacist licensure, as it is obsolete given recent Idaho law changes. The Board has already waived this requirement through resolution, and permanent action is needed.
- (2) Eliminate the Pharmacist-in-Charge requirement for Idaho licensed pharmacies, which serves as a paperwork and administrative burden on Idaho business.
- (3) Explore the creation of Licensure by Mutual Recognition, whereby Idaho would grant automatic reciprocity to pharmacists in states that grant automatic reciprocity to Idaho pharmacists. This would increase portability and mobility in a manner similar to the Nurse Licensure Compact.
- (4) Enable pharmacists to use alternatives to continuing education as a means to renew their license.
