OFFICIAL NOTICE

RE: Law changes Effective July 1, 2018

On July 1, 2018, new and revised Board of Pharmacy Administrative Rules will take effect. In addition, several Idaho Code changes were approved by the Legislature, with effective dates in March and July 2018. Please visit our website, https://bop.idaho.gov/code_rules/, and familiarize yourself with the new rule book format.

New Board Rule IDAPA 27.01.02.050. 07. Exemption from Separate Controlled Substance Registration.

All drug outlets doing business in or into Idaho who hold a valid license or registration from the Board are exempt from obtaining a separate controlled substance registration, but must maintain compliance with all requirements under Title 37, Chapter 27, Idaho Code.

New Board Rule IDAPA 27.01.02.021. 03. On-Time Annual Renewal Application. Licenses and registrations must be renewed annually to remain valid. Applications for renewal must be completed and submitted to the Board office prior to the license or registration expiration. Timely submission of the renewal application is the responsibility of each licensee or registrant. Licenses and registrations issued to individuals will expire annually on the last day of the individual's birth month, and on **December 31 for facilities**, unless an alternate expiration term or date is stated in the Board's rules.

New Fee Schedule Board Rule 27.07.02.023.02 Certificates of Registration and Licensure -- Facilities

What does this mean to you?

- **Current Distributor of Controlled Substance Registration will expire 6/30/2018 and will no longer require renewal.**
- **Effective July 1, 2018 -All Idaho registered Drug Outlets that have the ability to process or possess controlled substances according to Title 37, Chapter 27, Idaho Code will not need to hold a separate Distributor Registration in order to do so. This does not change any reporting requirements.**
- **Effective July 1, 2018, the annual renewal fee for a Manufacturer Registration is \$150.00.**

- **The annual Expiration Date for all facilities registered in Idaho is changing to December 31st. The transition will begin with this renewal.**
 - **When you complete the 2018 renewal, the new registration will be valid from July 1, 2018 to December 31, 2018 (6 months) and you will be charged the full renewal fee listed above.**
 - **2019 Renewal Notices will go out in Late October 2018. When you renew during this next period the registration will be valid from January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2019 (12 months). You will be charged at 50% of the annual renewal rate listed above.**

****IMPORTANT NOTICE****

The Board of Pharmacy is implementing a new licensing system. The changeover will begin on July 1, 2018. Please ensure your license is renewed prior to this date. Please review the following important dates and plan accordingly.

- **Renewal Period: April 9 – June 30, 2018**
- **System Down: July 1 – July 9, 2018 – No licenses, renewals, or applications will be processed and no license information will be available.**
- **Late Renewal Period: July 9 – July 31, 2018**
