RE: Law Changes Effective July 1, 2018 & Renewal Notice

On July 1, 2018, new and revised Board of Pharmacy Administrative Rules will take effect. In addition, several Idaho Code changes were approved by the Legislature, with effective dates in March and July 2018. Please visit our website, https://bop.idaho.gov/code_rules/, and familiarize yourself with the new rule book format.

New Board Rule 27.01.02.030. 03. Exemption from Separate Controlled Substance Registration. All pharmacists who are practicing in or into Idaho are exempt from obtaining a separate controlled substance registration, but must maintain compliance with all requirements under Title 37, Chapter 27, Idaho Code.

New Fee Schedule Board Rule 27.07.02.023. 01 License and Registrations

Board Rule IDAPA 27.01.02.021. 03. On-Time Annual Renewal Application. Licenses and registrations must be renewed annually to remain valid. Applications for renewal must be completed and submitted to the Board office prior to the license or registration expiration. Timely submission of the renewal application is the responsibility of each licensee or registrant. Licenses and registrations issued to **individuals will expire annually on the last day of the individual's birth month**, and on December 31 for facilities, unless an alternate expiration term or date is stated in the Board's rules.

What does this mean to you?

- **Current Controlled Substance Registration will expire 6/30/2018 and will no longer require renewal.**
- **Effective July 1, 2018, all Idaho licensed pharmacists will have the ability to process controlled substance prescriptions according to Title 37, Chapter 27, Idaho Code without maintaining a separate controlled substance registration.**
- **Effective July 1, 2018, the annual renewal fee for a pharmacist license will be \$130.00.**

- The annual expiration date for most individuals will be the last day of the individual's birth month. This transition will *NOT* begin until April of 2019. More information will be sent out next year before the renewal process begins.
- If you do not intend to renew your license please provide notification via email or another written form so we can update your file.

****IMPORTANT NOTICE****

The Board of Pharmacy is implementing a new licensing system. The changeover will begin on July 1, 2018. Please ensure your license is renewed prior to this date. Please review the following important dates and plan accordingly.

- **2018 Renewal Period: April 9 – June 30, 2018**
- **System Down: July 1 – July 9, 2018 – No licenses, renewals, or applications will be processed and no license information will be available.**
- **Late Renewal Period: July 9 – July 31, 2018**
