

**MINUTES OF THE

This meeting of the Board was held to discuss rule changes related to anti-malarial medications as related to COVID-19.

Chairman Holly Henggeler, PharmD, called the meeting to order at 2:28 p.m. Those in attendance telephonically included Dr. Henggeler, Kris Jonas, PharmD; Justin Messenger, PharmD, Rich de Blaquiere, PharmD; Nicki Chopski, PharmD, Executive Director; Ali Breshears, DAG; Wendy Shiell, Compliance Officer. Governor Little requested the Board hold an emergency meeting to address the possible stockpiling of the drug hydroxychloroquine.

Dr. Chopski presented draft language of Rule 704 to the Board. Following a brief discussion Dr. de Blaquiere motioned to accept the language with the discussed modifications. Dr. Messenger seconded and the motion carried.
